Dear friends of Imibala,

2024 has been another year of growth for Imibala.

Two new Imibala villages have been added, Hermanus and Moorreesburg, both to be operational in April 2025. Imibala is spreading its wings and will be able to serve an extra 1500 children next year, bringing the total number of children in the Sponsor a Child school uniform program to 5000

Our academic programs, along with our performing and creative arts programs, have grown significantly. We are now hosting a total of 875 children each week.

This number will increase to 1100 children once Imibala Hermanus and Moorreesburg are fully operational.

Imibala has also spread its wings in Europe and Imibala Trust UK, Imibala Stichting in the Netherlands and Imibala Verein in Germany are all fully operational allowing our European supporters to obtain a tax relief certificate. These offices function as a conduit and all donations are 100% transferred to The Imibala Trust in South Africa.

We are extremely proud of our Imibala children and what they have achieved this year, may they continue to shine brightly for years to come.


